Defiant Financial Services, LLC (DFS) a registered investment advisor strongly believes in protecting the confidentiality and security of information we collect about you. This notice refers to DFS by using the terms "us", "we" or "our". This notice describes our privacy policy and describes how we treat the information we receive ("Information") about you.

What type of nonpublic personal information do we collect: Information provided by you on applications or other forms such as your name, address Social Security number, date of birth, employment information, investment experience, and risk tolerance. Information about your transactions with us, such as your account balance, trading activity, parties to a transaction and credit/debit card usage.

Why We Collect and How We Use Information: We collect and use Information for business purposes with respect to our business relationships involving you. These business purposes include evaluating a request for products or services, administering our products or services and processing transactions requested by you. We may also use Information to offer you other products or services we provide.

How We Collect Information: We get most Information directly from you. The Information you provide us when applying for our products or services generally provides the Information we need. Disclosure of information about former customers: If an individual decides to close an account or otherwise becomes an inactive customer, we will continue to follow privacy practices described in this notice with respect to such individual.
